In a meeting held at the Punto de Sabor Restaurant in the Borough of the Bronx, New York, United States of North America, representatives of the Garifuna Coalition USA, Inc., Community Ethnic Development Organization (ODECO) and the USA Garífuna Bicentennial +10 Support Committee agreed to the following:

1. Our institutions and organizations are committed to develop complementary and nonparallel activities under framework of the celebration of the African Heritage Month in Honduras, Garífuna Bicentennial +10, the First Grand Garífuna Cultural Carnival and the Garifuna Coalition USA, Inc.'s VIII Garifuna Nation Honduras 2007 Conference, in commemoration of the Two Hundred Tenth Anniversary of the Arrival of the Garífuna Community to Honduras and Central America.
2. The Garifuna Coalition USA, Inc. assumes directly the organization and coordination of its planned activities in Honduras for 2007, as well as to work directly and brotherly with ODECO and other involved organizations interested in building unity and harmony, respect and tolerance among the African Descendant organizations and communities.
3. The Garifuna Coalition USA, Inc. for the sake of Central American integration will initiate the proceedings to reinstate its affiliation with the Central American Black Organization (CABO).
4. The General Programming of the African Heritage Month in Honduras, will include the activities programmed by the Coalition Garífuna the USA, Inc., National and international ODECO and other organizations interested in participating.
5. In addition, the Garifuna Coalition USA, Inc., ODECO and the other Afro Central American organizations in the United States, are committed to develop and maintain relations of mutual respect, tolerance, professionalism and solidarity.
